## Segregation of Solvent Wastes

Although it is difficult to recycle or reuse most of the solvent wastes generated at the University, there are still ways to minimize the cost of disposal and utilize the Btu value for beneficial use. When possible, we send all non-halogenated organic solvent wastes for use as cement kiln fuels. This allows the Btu value of the solvents to be utilized in the manufacture of cement rather than to be simply incinerated for destruction.
